

## Nashik

Nashik is in the northwest of Maharashtra, 185 km. This city is known as Grape City. Nashik is located to the banks of Godavari river and is important mythologically, historically, socially and culturally. Known for the temples on the banks of the Godavari, it has historically been one of the holy sites of the Hindu religion. It is one of the four cities that hosts the massive SinhasthaKumbhMela once every twelve years. Nashik was known as the city of roses (Gulshanabad). Now known as the city of Grapes. Efforts are on the growth of export quality rose farming and wine industries. This city is the third most industrialised city in Maharashtra after Mumbai and Pune.
