DAY 01 COLOMBO -KANDY

Day 03 NUWARA ELIYA

After Breakfast transfer NuwaraEliya.The tea factories found on most tea estates play a vital role in the final value of the manufactured tea..Proceed to visit Sita Amman temple.Evening commence of sightseeing of Nuwaraeliya,

NuwaraEliya -. All around NuwaraEliya you will see evidence of the British influence, houses like country cottages or Queen Ann style mansions. The Victoria Park, in the middle of the town, is a lovely place for a stroll or a picnic. Seasons may be absent elsewhere in Sri Lanka, but here you can read them by the flowers, which bloom in the spring (March to May) and the fall (August and September). These are the “seasons” when low-country folk flock to NuwaraEliya to escape the sea level heat and humidity.Check in at the hotel.Rest of the day at leisure in the hotel. Overnight stay at Hotel NuwaraEliya

DAY 04 BENTOTA

After Breakfast proceed to Bentota.Optional:En route visit Turtle hatchery and 01 hour bentota river boat safari.Check in the Hotel .**Bentota**– is the first National Holiday Resort developed by the Ceylon Tourist Board as a planned resort..Water sports facilities are available as in the Beruwela Resort Many interesting sightseeing tours are possible from here, such as the Turtle Hatchery, Mask factory, Boat trips on Bentota River etc.Rest of the day at leisure in the hotel.Overnight stay at Hotel Bentota.

DAY 05 COLOMBO

After breakfast transfer to Colombo–Visit Fort, the former British administrative center and military garrison, Sea Street - the Goldsmith’s quarters in the heart of Pettah, the Bazaar area where there is also a Hindu Temple with elaborate stone carvings, the Kaymans Gate with the Belfry at the original gate to enter the Fort, the Dutch Church of Wolfendhaal dating back to 1749, Kelaniya Buddhist Temple, Davatagaha Mosque, Colombo Museum and the Natural History Museum are some of the sites to be visited. Also visit the BMICH (*Bandaranaike Memorial International Conference Hall*), see the replica of Avukana Buddha and the Independence Square.Pmshopping in Colombo. Overnight stay at Hotel , Colombo
